PLAY THE NOTES AS SHORT AS POSSIBLE AND WITHOUT PLAYING TOGETHER. IF YOU PLAY TOGETHER WITH ANOTHER PERFORMER OF THE CLICK. STOP FOR 5"

LISTEN AROUND YOU AND IMPROVISE

PRESS PLAY (TAPE)

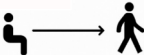

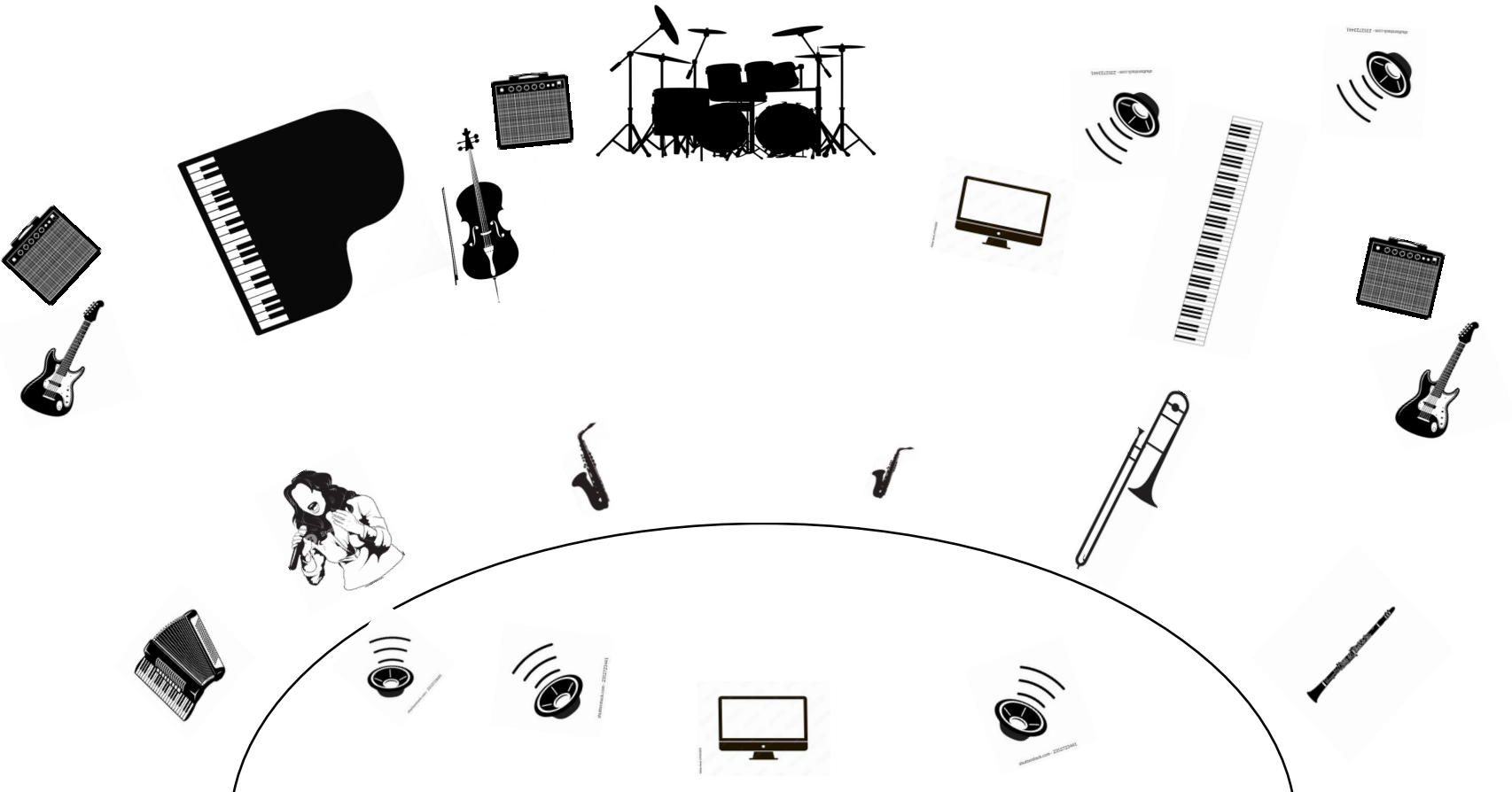
